- 1886 Plat of Survey by Orson Burlingame, Surveyor, shows a section subdivision of Section 33, T32N-R27W. The corner monument is not described and no witnesses are given.
- 1972 Certified Survey No. 9 recorded by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, indicates that this corner was established on the extension south of a very old fenceline. The survey shows a concrete monument 33 feet north of the corner position. No corner monument is shown at the corner position. The record measurements in this survey along the South Line of the SW 1/4 of Section 33 compare very closely to Burlingame's measurement.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a P.K. Nail 33 feet south of an existing 4 inch diameter concrete monument on the extension south of a very old fence. Burlingame's measurement west from this corner is 2656. The present measurement west from this corner to an existing concrete monument at the position of the SW corner of Section 33 is 2654.3. This position is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
