

Original Survey by James H. Mullett in 1848. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 30" Alum. monument/4" dia. Alum. cap in centerline of County Road 320 (East-West) and County Road 571 (North-South). This corner was set by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, in about 1979. This survey has been used for control in several surveys and is accepted as the best evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner

30" Aluminum Monument/4" dia. Aluminum cap stamped for corner:

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5" White Ash	N25°E	120.98 feet
9" dia. Cedar	S57°E	102.00 feet
