I, William Lenca, in a field survey on Dec. 05, 1994, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- 1847: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Maple, 8", S53°W, 123 lks; Aspen, 9", N44°W, 210 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by shore line erosion.
- 1958: Plat of Survey by Robert Olsen, surveyor, shows this corner as being a 12" dia. cedar post 509' East of the Quarter Corner between Sections 23 & 26. This corner has been destroyed by shore line erosion.
- 1990: Plat of Survey by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, shows a 5/8" x 24" Iron rod/Ident. cap set 402.26 feet East of the 1/4 Corner between Sections 23 & 26, and on an extension of the line between said 1/4 corner and the Section Corner 1/2 mile West.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found the 5/8" x 24" iron rod at the edge of the shore of Green Bay, and just inside the tree line as indicated in our 1990 Plat of Survey. The distance from this location West to the 1/4 Corner between Sections 23 & 26 is 402.26 feet compared to the GLO distance of 468.6 feet. The lot lines to the South, established in Olsen's 1958 Plat of Survey, run parallel with the line established between this corner and the 1/4 corner between Sections 23 & 26. We accepted the position of the 5/8" x 24" Iron rod as the best available evidence of the position of the original Section Line, and as a reference to the Meander Corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2-1/2" dia. Alum. pipe/3-1/4" dia. Alum. Cap stamped for corner location in place of existing 5/8" x 24" iron rod:

NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with steel tape. Distances to trees are to nail in side of tree.
