Private Claims 1 2 3 I, <u>William Lenca</u>, in a field survey on <u>Mar.</u>, 19 99 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the 4 5 United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan 6 Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below: NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate. 10 1 12 A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Birch, 8" - S01°E - 10 lks.; Black Ash, 10" - N02°W - 14 lks. All original 1848: evidence for this corner has been destroyed by farming activities. Survey by Albert Hass, Co. Surveyor, shows this corner as it relates to other corners in Section 18. Survey states "Set 4" 1901-L.C.R.C. No. 772 by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461 - Found remains of post at intersection of old fences N-S and E-W -1987: set 1" x 18" Iron Pipe - TIES: W. Birch, 7" - N12°W - 5.06'; Black Ash, 4" - S80°E - 17.10'; W. Birch, 6" - S20°W -B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: We found a 1 inch diameter x 18 inch iron pipe and 3 B.T.'s as described in L.C.R.C. No. 772 (see part "A"). The pipe is located at the intersection of ancient fences running North - South - East - West. We also found the point and remains of an old squared wood post at the corner location. From the age of the fences, it appears that they were built from the 1901 survey by Albert Hass. We accepted the remains of the old squared wood post as the corner set by Albert Hass. Since Hass stated that he set this corner from a Government B.T., we accepted this corner as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe 30" long/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location; a was a LASS 6" dia. White Ash N460E 11.10 feet Scr. NBT 6" dia. White Ash S290E 21.65 feet Scr. NBT 8" dia. White Ash S480W 33.31 feet Scr. NBT 10" dia. White Birch (Ex. B.T.) Loro was N540W 30.99 feet Scr. NBT Metal Survey Sign Post South 1.0 feet NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with steel tape.
