I hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1848: Original Survey by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Cedar, 16", N25°E, 13 lks. Cedar, 10", N80°W, 19 lks. All original evidence has been destroyed by Highway construction.

1977: L.C.R.C. No. 167 by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, states that a 2" Alum. Pipe/Magnets top and bottom was re-set using 1877 railroad ties. G. B. Wilson's ties- Centerline U.S. Hwy. "41", West, 96 feet.

Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

In our 1995 Remonumentation Survey, we recovered a 2 inch diameter aluminum pipe with a 3-1/4 inch diameter aluminum cap marked "100 YEAR FLOOD MENOMINEE RIVER". This Corner is located 9 1/2 feet East of the centerline of U.S. Highway 41 and in the centerline of an East - West County Road. This corner position has been used by local surveyors for 18 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.



Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Accepted existing 2" dia. Alum. Pipe/3-1/4" dia. cap marked "100 YEAR FLOOD MENOMINEE RIVER" in Mon. Box.

5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/2" dia. Alum. cap marked "Witness Marker"

South 28.66 feet

P.K. Nail in Power Pole

S32⁰W 39.34 feet

Chisel mark in North End of Metal Culvert

N36°W 32.15 feet

Metal Survey Sign Post

South 29.1 feet

NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with a steel tape. Distances to trees are to nail in side of tree.
