B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(MC E of J05)[009] No evidence of original survey or subsequent restoration found. Corner position reestablished by extending a line from the Southeast corner of Section 11 West along a line that is parallel to the GLO plat relationship (North line of S11 = S 89deg-47min E, South line S11 = West) and GLO notes. GLO distance from the Section corner to this position is 30.96 Chains (2043.36 feet); this position falls near un-stable bank. Monumented witness position 2033.36 feet West of Section Corner and 15 Feet from the Waters Edge. Position is accepted as a careful and faithful WITNESS TO the position of the original corner.
