B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.

We Recovered a 4 inch diameter concrete monument and old squared post in location matching record measurmements as shown in George Wilson's survey dated 1970. This corner has been accepted and used by local surveyors for at least 27 years, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Survey by George B. Wilson, RLS No. 17607, states this corner was re-set by using single proportionate measurement. The corner is shown in relation to other corners in Section 13. No corner monument is described and no B.T.'s are given.
