

I, ________, in a field survey on _______, 19 ______ do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.



A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1847: Original Survey by H. Floyd - B.T.'s - W. Birch, 10" - N40°W - 23 lks.; Spruce, 12" - S53°W - 32 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.

Original Survey (Sec. Subd.) by James H. Mullett - B.T.'s - Beech, 10" - N74^oE - 14 lks.; W. Pine, 18" - S30^oE - 24 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.

1986: Certified Survey No. 468 by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, shows this corner as it relates to other corners in Section 12, T35N-R28W. My field notes indicate that we set an HDR5' aluminum rod monument with 3-1/4" alum. cap at an ancient fence corner. TIES: 18" W. Pine - N68°E - 16.85'; Maple, 5" - S40°E - 57.35'; Maple, 8" - N38°W - 38.30'; Maple, 8" - S40°W - 33.41'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found an HDR5' aluminum rod monument with 3-1/4 inch diameter cap and 4 B.T.'s in place as described in my 1986 survey (see part A). The corner falls at an ancient fence corner with fences running North and West and a newer single strand fence running East. This position fits well with measurements to other corners in the area, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Accepted existing 3/4" x 5' long aluminum rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner:

NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with steel tape. Distances to trees are to nail in side of tree.
