A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by Francis Coleman - B.T.'s - Cedar, 10" - N450E - 23 lks.; Cedar, 12" - S430W - 21 lks. All original 1852: evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We computed the single proportional location for this corner, traversed to it and searched the area. The corner position falls in the centerline of a North - South County Road and at a definite kink in the road. Since no evidence of the original corner or subsequent restoration was found, we set the corner on line and midway between the NE and NW Corners of Section 34, and accepted this location as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
