

- Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
  - Original Survey by Francis Coleman B.T.'s Beech, 10", N270W, 31 lks & W. Pine, 18", S360E, 15 lks All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by farming activities.
  - 1890: Old Michigan/Wisconsin Railroad Map shows ties to this corner - 480 feet West along Section Line and 450 feet North along 1/4 Line. No description of the corner monument is given,
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We set this corner on an old fence line E-W and at a distance of 480 feet West of the centerline of the old grade of the Michigan/Wisconsin Railroad. We measured South from this location along the N-S 1/4 Line of Section 36, to the centerline of said railroad grade, and found this distance to be 450' as indicated on the old railroad map. This position fits well with other corners in the area, and is accented as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. the area, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
