



No. 743 recorded by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461, states that a Railroad Spike was set proportionately between the NW Cor. of Section 18 & SW Corner of Section 19. Ties: 6" Ced. - N540E - 54.18'; 9" Tam. - S350E - 57.97'; 8" 1986: Ced. - S41°W - 54.71°; 6" Tam. - N46°W - 46.84°.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a railroad spike and 4 Bearing Trees marked NBT as described in L.C.R.C. No. 743. (See part "A") The railroad spike was found 5 feet North of the centerline of an East - West County Road (C.R. 374) and at a proportional location between the NW Corner (A-7) and the Southwest Corner (A-9) of Section 19, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location in Monument Box:
