

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
 - Original Survey by George Adair B.T.'s Hemlock, 10" N190W 36 lks.; Black Ash, 14" S420E 09 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We computed the single proportional location for this corner, traversed in to it and searched the area. We found no evidence of the original corner accessories, or evidence of subsequent restoration. This location fits well with a GLO terrain call to a swamp edge 1.22 chains West, and is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner; Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe/3-1/4" dia. Alum cap stamped for corner location:
