I, William Lenca, in a field survey on Aug. 27, 1996 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- 1852: Original Survey by George Adair - B.T.'s - Sugar Maple, 8" - N19°E - 35 lks.; Hemlock, 10" - S31°W - 21 lks. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by logging activities.
- 1983: Notes of SURVEY by Mel Davis, RLS No. 16926 states: Found squared wood post and possible remains of original Hemlock witness (decayed) - set 1-1/2" x 42" iron pipe." B.T.'s - Ced., 8" - S75°E - 33.18'; Ced., 9" - S23°W - 13.35'; Ced., 6" - N74°W - 41.47'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We recovered a 1 inch diameter by 42 inch long iron pipe and B.T.'s from the 1983 survey as described in part "A" above. We found remnants of a large hemlock stump to badly decayed to determine if it was an original. The existing iron pipe fits very closely with a double proportional position between corners G-1 to G-4 and between corners E-3 to H-3, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 2" dia. Aluminum Pipe/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location:
