

Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Survey by George Adair - B.T.'s - Tamarack, 12"- N29°E, 16 lks; Spruce, 10" - S03°W - 11 lks. No original evidence found.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We tied in the Southwest Corner and the Northwest Corner of Section 1, T37N-R25W, and computed the proportional position for this corner based on the GLO measurement of this line. We then traversed to our computed location and found a 2-1/2" diameter Iron Pipe with a 3-1/4"diameter Brass cap stamped for the corner location. This monument was set by the Bureau of Land Management in a survey of Indian Lands, and fits very well with the proportioned position for this corner. We therefore accepted the BLM Monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.
