I, William Lenca, in a field survey on Aug. 14, 1900 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1848: Original Survey by George E. Adair - B.T.'s - Cedar, 10" - N45°E - 0.21 chs.; Tamarack, 15" - S24°W - 0.16 chs. All original evidence for this corner has been destroyed by county road improvements.

1986: L.C.R.C. No. 739 (Book 3) by William Lenca, RLS No. 26461 - Set RR Spike in centerline of Co. Rds N - S - E. This position fits well with corners North & South - TIES: PP - N08°E - 278.74'; PP - S55°E - 47.10'; Anchor Pole - S51°W - 41.14'; Basswood, 8" - N77°W - 41.85'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

We found a Railroad Spike in the centerline of county roads running North - South and East, along with the Ties as described in part "A" above. The measurement from this corner to the 1/4 Corner North is 2642.36 feet. Measuring South from this location, we find an old fence running West at a distance of 1321 feet and an old fence running West at a distance of 2640.5 feet. We accepted the location of the railroad spike as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Set 5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/3-1/4" dia. Alum. cap stamped for corner location in Monument Box:

5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/2" dia. Alum. cap marked "WITNESS MARKER"	N53°E	37.64 feet	1.0' N. of Road Sign
5/8" x 24" Iron Rod/2" dia. Alum. cap marked "WITNESS MARKER"	S53°E	47.86 feet	1.0' S. of Power Pole
5" dia. Cedar	S38°W	47.23 feet	Scr. NBT
Twin 6" dia. White Ash	N47°W	48.98 feet	Scr. NBT
Metal Survey Sign Post	S53°E	48.5 feet	

NOTE: All bearings are magnetic bearings. All distances are measured with steel tape. Distances to trees are to nail in side of tree.
