We then measured 127 feet West (1.92 chains GLO record) and 335 feet East (5.08 chains GLO record) to swamp edges. We found that the GLO record measurements fit well with the re-established corner position. We accepted this location as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
