A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(H03) Quarter corner common to Sections 3 and 10. 1852: E.C. Martin, DS. Set quarter section post witnessed by Tamarack 12 S60E 28 links (18.48'), Cedar 8 N53W 8 links (5.28'). 1951: Michigan DNR (Dean DeLameter PS#5778) Set 1" pipe with 4" Brass cap from original evidence witnessed by 8" Tamarack S60E 28 links (18.48'), 8" Cedar S30W 10 links (6.60').

(I02) Quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 3. 1852: E.C. Martin, DS. Set quarter section post witnessed by Tamarack 14 S74W 32 links (21.12'), Tamarack 12 N80E 24 links (15.84'). 1952: Michigan DNR (Dean DeLameter PS#5778) Set 1" pipe with 4" Brass cap from original evidence witnessed by 6" Spruce N53W 15 links (9.90'), 8" Cedar S77E 22 links (14.52').

3. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(H03) Accepted found MDNR Monument, trace remains of mound at OBT location SE, and Two NBT Witnesses (NW face and trace scribing dead and down; SW tip out dead and down). Position is accepted as a careful and faithful PERPETUATION of the position of the original corner.

(I02) Accepted found MDNR Monument and One NBT Witnesses (SE in good condition). Position is accepted as a careful and faithful PERPETUATION of the position of the original corner.
