instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(H05) Quarter corner common to Sections 10 and 15. 1852: E. C. Martin, DS. Set Quarter section
corner post witnessed by Tamarack 16 S33W 17 links (11.22'), Tamarack 12 N60E 20 links (13.20').
Squared 15" Cedar tipped out NW.
(G07) Section corner common to Sections 15, 16, 21, and 22. 1852: E. C. Martin, DS. Set section
corner post witnessed by Cedar 16 S43W 8 links (5.28'), Tamarack 16 N42E 28 links (18.48'). 1955:
Michigan DNR (Billy Buckler PS#8887) Set 1" pipe with 4" Brass cap from original evidence witnessed
by 7" Cedar N88W 28 links (18.48'), 6" Tamarack S83E 29 links (19.14').

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(H05) No evidence of original survey. Corner position reestablished by single proportionate
measurement between the Northeast corner and the Northwest corner of Section 15. Position is
accepted as a careful and faithful REESTABLISHMENT of the position of the original corner. (NOTE:
Calculated location would fall in the Center of above described Squared 15" Cedar if it were to be
standing vertically and not a tip out.)
(G07) Accepted found Michigan DNR monument, remains of SW OBT, and Two NBT witnesses (Both living).
Position is accepted as a careful and faithful PERPETUATION of the position of the original corner.
