B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

K-9) Section corner common to Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26

Found 1" O.D. pipe in monument box per Liber 1, Page 566 and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Corner is in the Centerline of the East-West road and in the Centerline of the road to the South.

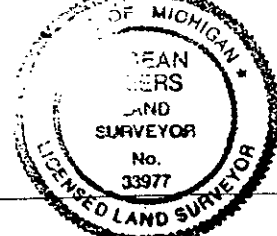
