

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- 1 W 1/16 Corner common to Section 2 & 11, T23N, R5W Fd. remains of large pine stump in swamp for possible witness #1. Dug 3' x 3' area at record bearing and distance from WPS but no evidence of cedar stake was found. The dug position is S84°W 14'± from calculated position for corner. Thus set 2" Alum. Cap on 5/8" x 34" rebar per Standard BLM procedure. The grid distance E & W is 1310.56' (1311.42' CSR)
- 3 N 1/16 Corner common to Sec. 10 & 11, T23N, R5W Found 5/8" capped rebar #12028 per Roser. 5/8" CIR accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the corner. All three Roser witnesses have been cut.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- 1 Stamped 2" Aluminum Cap on 5/8" x 34" long iron rebar. Add two 1'± large stones around.
