- H-13) Quarter Section Corner common to Section 34, T24N, R7W and Section 3, T23N, R7W; Found 5/8" Iron as recorded in Liber 1, Page 624. Corner is in centerline of road East-West. This corner is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

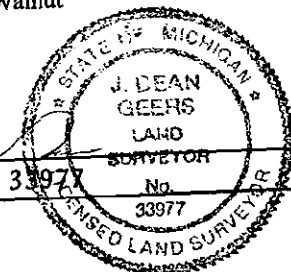
