A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

K-10 Found a 1/2" boat spike in a monument box on the C/L of Middle Belt Road running North and 25' ± South of the C/L of Elm Road running East per Noble Brook Farms (not recorded) 1939. This corner is 0.46' North of the midpoint between K-9 and K-11. Checks closely the distance North to K-9 per Supervisor's Middle Belt Ten Mile Road Sub. No. 1 L. 56 P. 54 (1946) and South to K-11 per Kemberton Park Sub. L. 36 P. 27 (1925).

Measure North 2648.09' to K-9 (G.L.O. = 2640.0') (Supervisor's Middle Belt Ten Mile Road Sub. No. 1 = 2648.5')  
Measure South 2649.01' to K-11 (G.L.O. = 2640.0') (Kemberton Park Sub. = 2649.08')

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K-10 Replaced the boat spike with a 5/8" x 24" rebar with brass cap stamped "Oakland County Remonumentation P.S. #25854" in an existing monument box.

Set PK Nail & Tag Stamped "Oakland Co. Remonumentation P.S. #25854" in NW Side P. Pole N 26° E 130.18'  
Set PK Nail & Tag Stamped "Oakland Co. Remonumentation P.S. #25854" in SE Side P. Pole N 42° E 66.24'  
Set PK Nail & Tag Stamped "Oakland Co. Remonumentation P.S. #25854" in S Side P. Pole S 75° E 66.98'  
Set PK Nail & Tag Stamped "Oakland Co. Remonumentation P.S. #25854" in NE Side P. Pole N 51° W 36.90'

The selected location is accepted by the Contractor and is generally accepted by professional surveyors as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
