## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

I found a 1" Iron near the surface of the ground about 4' west of new fence to south & 10' North of south edge of E-W ancient road bed & on south edge of field drive. Tree line E-W and old fence lying down is 12' m/l south at edge of road bed. The newer fence to the south is built approximately on an ancient fence which is lying down. No occupation line is visible to the north. Upon excavation, I found the iron to be surrounded by many 3"-6" I did not find any stone that would fit the Hyde, 1889 description.

Evans, 1978, witness uses two of the same witnesses as OCRC, pre-1949: 30" Elm at S15"W 95.7' and the Maple at about 70.5' at S20°E. That maple is still standing and is now a 12" twin. OCRC recites a "fence line corner post" at 14.4' which is consistent with the location of the old fence line E-W on the south side of the old road bed. All other witnesses are now gone.

I accept the i" iron and stones as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. No evidence is known to me that would lead me to believe that the corner should be at another location.

## C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

Set 4"x20" Harrison Cast Iron Monument, stamped "County Surveyor" and "26457" above the 1" Iron which was driven down. I also placed some of the stones back around the monument.
