B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. There was a blue paint line running North & East and a yellow paint line running South and two trees with a great deal of paint on them, about 50 feet apart, near the calculated search area. These were used for logging the area and are within a few feet of where I ultimately set the corner. Corner was re-established by double proportionate measurement between the SW Corner of Section 4 West, the South  $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of Section 2 East, NE Corner of Section 3 North and the SE Corner of Section 10 South.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the Corner position I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" split base aluminum pipe with a 3" cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N R41W, S2, S3, S10, S11, 2000, P.S. 17610. I established three bearing trees and a reference object.
