A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Corner established by Wells Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, June 19, 1851. Set Wood Post.

ORIGINAL BEARING TREES:

14" Cedar N35°W 2 Links (1.32 feet)

16" Cedar S10°W 11 Links (7.26 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. All original evidence was destroyed by a road and farming. Corner was re-established by single proportionate measure between opposite corners, North & South.

Research on file with the Ontonagon County Remonumentation Program Representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a $2\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" aluminum pipe with a 3" cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N, R41W, S1, S2, $\frac{1}{4}$, 2000, P.S. 17610. I established two bearing trees and two reference objects.

Nail in 5" Aspen S43°W 111.89' - Nail in P. Pole N27°E 37.22'

Nail in 10" Spruce N87°E 50.75' - 6' Steel Sign Post, North 0.72'
