A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by John Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, July 1847. Set Yellow Birch Post.

ORIGINAL BEARING TREES:

6" Y. Birch N60°E 40 Links (26.40 Feet)
8" Y. Birch N60°W 22 Links (14.52 Feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original bearing trees or evidence was found. Timber was cut 2 years ago South of this Corner. Corner was re-established on line and equal distance between opposite corners East and West.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x30" split base aluminum pipe with a 3" Cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N, T49N, R40W, $\frac{1}{4}$, 2000, P.S. 17610. I established three bearing trees and a reference object.

Nail in 6" W. Ash N45°W 37.88' - 6' Steel Sign Post, North 0.58'
