5. Private Claims

I, Joseph C. Domitrovich, in a field survey on December 14, 2000, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(D-7) ¼ Corner common to Sections 17 and 20, T51N, R38W1846- H. and S.W. Higgins set a ¼ post

14" Sugar S 60°E 11 links

24" Hemlock N 30°W 6 links

I found no record of subsequent restoration.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original ¼ corner or accessories. The area of the corner now falls in an open pasture area. The property owner, Clarence Wilbur, owns the entire section to the North and South of this corner. Only containment fences are evident. I have concluded that this corner is lost and have reestablished it by single proportionate measurement.

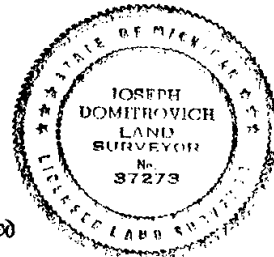
C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a ¾" x 48" aluminum rod with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T51N, R38W; ¼; S.17, S.20; 2000; P.S. 37273.
