I, Joseph C. Domitrovich, in a field survey on November 30, 2000, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E-7) Corner Common to Sections 16, 17, 20 & 21, T51N, R38W

1846- H. and S.W. Higgins set a post.

10" Sugar N 35°E 15 links

12" B. Ash S 60°W 20 links

I found no record of subsequent restoration.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. At the corner position there is now a North-South Barbwire fence constructed over 30 years ago along the long accepted Section line. The Section line was bulldozed to put in the fence and in so doing destroyed any remaining evidence of it. I created a position for the section corner using the proportionate position for the latitude. (Between ¼ Corner ½ mile south and Section Corner one mile North. Section Corner is a 5/8" iron pin at fence corner with old location poster facing it.) For the departure of the Section corner I held the North-South Fenceline. I believe this position to be the best representation of the position of the original section corner.


C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 2 ½" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T51N, R38W; S.16, S.17, S.20, S.21; 2000; P.S. 37273.
