A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner;

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. At the corner position I found the iron pipe as called for by Mead records. Old blazes and location posters facing this corner indicate that this pipe has been used and accepted as the true corner for many years. Distances to other corners in the area differ considerably from record GLO but this is not inconsistent with work done elsewhere in this township by the original surveyors. I have accepted the iron pipe as the best representation of the true section corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I sawed off the iron pipe at ground level and drove a 1/2" x 48" aluminum rod inside of it and placed a 3" diameter aluminum cap on it stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T51N, R38W; S. 15, S. 16, S. 21, S. 22; 2000; P.S. 37273. Ties:
