I, Joseph C. Domitrovich, in a field survey on May 22, 2000, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(M-6) ¼ Corner Common to Sections 13, T52N, R39W & Section 18, T52N, R38W.

1845 - William A. Burt set a Fir post with ties:

12" Sugar	N 58°E	24 links
26" Hemlock	S 35°W	7 links

I found no record of subsequent restoration.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

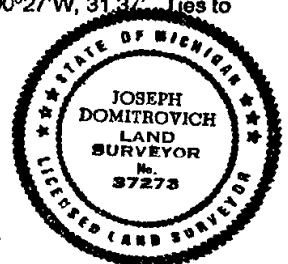
I found no remains of original corner or accessories. At the corner position is East - West gravel Aho Road and a fence line running North. I established a position for the ¼ corner in centerline of the road on the extension of the fence to the North. This position works well with section corner to North and with other corners on the Range line to the South. It also works well with 1/16 fence to the West. I accepted this position as the ¼ corner.

Research on file with County Remonumentation Representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" x 24" Iron pin with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T52N, R39W; R38W; ¼; S. 13, S. 18; 2000; P.S. 37273. I also established a reference monument (R.M.) to the North, a 2 ½" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter cap stamped to indicate that the ¼ corner is S 00°27'W, 31.37'. Ties to the corner:

6" Soft Maple	S 60°E	44.31'
14" Ash	S 44°W	38.08'
Power Pole	N 73°W	98.70'
R.M.	N 00°27'00"E	31.37'
NE Cor. Sec. 13	N 00°23'27"E	2648.93'



NOTE: Bearings to witness objects are magnetic. Distances are to a nail in side of the witness object unless noted.
