

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C-3) Comer Common to Sections 6, 5, 7 & 8, T52N, R38W.

1846 - S.W. Higgins set a post with ties:

12" Hemlock 12" Sugar

1974 - R.S. Scott Engineering Company shows this corner as being a 1" pipe and proposed monument on their Lakeshore Drive R.O.W. Plans.

1977 - Ned Hawley noted in his copy of the original field notes that this corner was a pipe and the Southeast corner of the Joas Farm.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. I found the pipe called for by R.S. Scott. It had been disturbed by power line clearing. I re-established the original position of the pipe from information from the R.O.W. plans. It falls on an old east-west fence line, on extension of Lakeshore Drive to the North and East. Distances to section corners East and West vary considerably with GLO but this in not inconsistent with work elsewhere by S.W. Higgins. Distances North to Creek calls work reasonably well with GLO. This was a corner of the old Joas Farm which was in existence before 1930. I have accepted the position of the pipe as the best representation of the original

C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the comer:

Corner is a 2 ½" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T52N, R38W; S. 6, S. 5, S. 7, S. 8; 2000; P.S. 37273. Corner falls 7' North of E-W pole line on extension of county road to North and East and 30' South of 2 track road. Ties:
