Beauregard in a field survey on June, 1994, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(I-2) Wood  $\frac{1}{4}$  section post set by William R. Coon in 1839.

Wits: 10" Aspen N  $79\frac{1}{4}^\circ$  W 12 links

6" Aspen S  $68^\circ$  E 13 links

Guy R. Veal in 1935 found  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" iron pipe above ground set by engineers of Consumers Power Co. from original evidence in 1909. Set a regulation iron post 1" diam., 24" long in a conc. mon. 24" long, 6" diam., 18" in ground with brass cap marked Secs. 2 & 3, Government Deputy Surveyor. Dependent Resurvey of T26N, R2E.

Wits: (6" Poplar N  $79^\circ$  E 18 links) (7" Poplar S  $15\frac{1}{4}^\circ$  W 14 links)

Norman C. Caldwell P. S. #12018 between 1968-1981 found U.S. GLO mon. No references marked. Corner Registry recorded L.2, P. 93 in April of 1969.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(I-2) Found U.S. GLO mon. set in 1935 from Dependent Resurvey by Veal. Mon. in good condition  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " E. of corner fence post,  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " above ground. No 1935 wits. found. Placed  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" bar alongside monument.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(I-2)  $\frac{1}{4}$  corner common between Secs. 2 & 3, T26N, R2E.

U.S. GLO monument set in 1935 from Dependent Resurvey by Veal is in good condition and is  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " E. of corner fence post,  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " above ground, and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. (Placed  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" bar alongside monument).

7" Ash N  $40^\circ$  E 14.68'

4" Birch N  $60^\circ$  E 24.13'

9" Ash S  $55^\circ$  W 18.10'

5" Ash S  $60^\circ$  E 27.33'
