Section Corner common to Sections 17, 18, 19 & 20, T48N R40W.

I, Earl W. Applekamp, in a field survey on July 02, 1998 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Wells Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, May 24, 1851. Set Wood Post.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. A Township road was established along the East-West Section line about 1915. This road is now abandoned but still very visible. M-DOT Highway prints dated 1963 indicated a 1½" pipe was at the corner location. I found this pipe on the Northerly edge of the abandoned 10 foot wide roadway. This position was in agreement with the distance shown on the highway drawings. A fence line runs North and South from this location. I accepted this location as being the only logical position for the corner and monumented it. This corner is in a large swampy and brushy area.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 2½"x30" aluminum pipe with a 3" stamped cap over the 1½" existing pipe. The cap is stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N R40W, S17, S18, S19, S20, 1998, P.S. 17610. I established the following bearing objects.
