

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. Corner falls in Old Highway M-28 which has been in existence since about 1920. I found a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin in the center-line of the road at the corner position. This iron pin was used for several surveys by E.W. Applekamp, P.S. # 17610 in 1984 and later. This position is in conformance with the original field notes calling a stream East of the corner. I accepted the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin and monumented the corner as described in "C".

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 3" cap on the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pin 3" below the top of blacktop. The cap was stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T48N R41W, S23, S24, S25, S26, 1998, P.S. 17610. I established a reference as shown above.
