B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence could be found due to logging activity. I found a 1 1/2" iron pipe as noted above. The corner has been used by others including Keweenaw Land and Champion, Inc. and is generally accepted as the meander corner by use and acceptance and is the only possible corner position due to all the development referenced to it.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I updated the corner position to state and county specifications by replacing the 1 1/2" iron pipe with a 4' x 3/4" aluminum marsh rod with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap stamped: County Remonumentation; M.C.; S-29, S-28; T48N, R42W; 1994; RLS 28410. I established the following bearing trees and reference object: 4" balsam fir - N16°E, 11.11 feet; 4" ash - N85°E, 8.51 feet; 3" balsam fir - S58°E, 6.29 feet; 6 foot steel rail with sign - S35°W, 1.43 feet.
