I, Richard L. Drahn in a field survey on December 3, 1997, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt on 6/27/1848. Original B.T.s --- 8" Hemlock S.70 W. 5 links (3.3') --- 6" Sugar East 11 links (7.26') ---

Corner restored by Richard L. Drahn (21564) on 7/12/77 from the remains of the two original B.T.s, line trees and the distance N & S to recovered corners. He set a 2" X 5' iron pipe with a 3" stamped brass cap and the following:

9"	Hemlock	S.86 E.	18.6'
9"	Sugar Maple	S.11 W.	24.5'
7'	Metal sign post	N.84 W.	2.0'

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner recorded in Ontonagon County in Liber 1, Page 147 on 4/25/79.

Research form on file with Ontonagon County records.

Recovered the monument as described and the B.T.s as follows:

14"	Hemlock	N.10 W.	13.55'
11"	Hemlock	S.86 E.	18.50'
12"	Sugar Maple	S.16 W.	24.36'
7'	Steel sign rail	N.82 W.	2.01'

Hemlock roots and bark still remain from the original Hemlock B.T. and only a depression remains of the original Sugar.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

New bearing object referenced:

14" Sugar Maple N.52 W. 6.68'
