

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Restored corner position from the remains of the two original bearing trees. is a large shallow depression. The second is now a wind-thrown stump hole with downwind "line" of hemlock knots buried in the mud. Position lays within 1.9 feet of a single proportion N-S measure between 1 corner south and hemlock line tree stump north. Distance to recovered quarter corner east is within 3.6 feet of the east 1/2 mile distance.
