Drahn, in a field survey on June 17, 19 96, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt on June 30, 1848. Original B.T.s --- Sugar 8" N.55 W. 39 links (25.74') --- Sugar 10" S.55 E. 27 links (17.82') M. Larson on 5/7/35 recovered the SE Sugar and a Y. Birch witness tree, all still scribed. Corner restored by Donald D. Lappala, RLS 12585, on 6/22/70 from the original scribed Cedar post, the remains of the two original B.T.s (one still scribed) and a live GLO witness tree with blazes. He set a 2 1/2" iron pipe with a stamped, 3" brass cap and the following new B.T.s:--- 6" (9") Hemlock N.47 E. (N.46 E.) 27.5' (27.35') --- 10" Yellow Birch (now dead and down) S.25 E. (S.24 E.) 25.0' --- 12" (12") Hemlock (now a dead Hemlock stub) S.60 W. (S.60 W.) 22.1'

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Corner recorded in Ontonagon County in USFS Liber, Page V-13 on 9/14/72.

Act 74 research form on file with Ontonagon County records.

Recovered the monument as described and the bearing trees as noted in parentheses above.

Shallow depressions are all that remain of the two original B.T.s. The witness tree recovered in 1935 and 1970 is now a 23" live Yellow Birch with GLO blaze.
