I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 3 04/07/2010 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E11) Corner common to Sections 28-29-32-33. 1846 - Established by S.W.Higgins Deputy Surveyor. Set
post. Hemlock 20 N70E 14 links, Sugar 16 S67W 22 links. Corner shown on old mining company survey
drawing ca. 1907-1910. Description of monument is not noted but bearings and distances are given to
adjacent Government corners. This drawing, or a copy of it, resides at the offices of Steven Hein
PS, Laurium, MI. 1976 - Recorded by K.L.Sackett RLS. Reestablished 5-19-76 at 2" O.D. iron pipe.
This pipe fits with stream north and 1/4 corner west. Has been used as corner for many years. NBTs:
7" Birch S50E 7.6', 5" Sugar N27W 14.3', 4" Sugar S31W 13.3'.

(3-Sec. 33) North 1/16 corner between Sections 32 and 33. Not established in the original survey.
Found no record that this corner was established in ca. 1907-1910 mining company survey of Sections
31, 32, and 33. Found no record of subsequent monumentation.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(E11) Found an iron pipe of approximate record diameter, top mushroomed, estimated to be 1.5" O.D.,
set firm, at record bearing and distance from two remaining 1976 witnesses: the Y.Birch SE and Sugar
NW, both in good condition with overgrown blazes. The position of the pipe is in substantial accord
with the bearings and distances given on the mining company survey drawing, and I accept the pipe as
the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

(3-Sec. 33) Established the corner midway and on the Section line between Section corner 1345.32'
northerly and Quarter corner 1345.32' southerly. The true bearing of this line was observed to be
S04 deg. 12'50"W. A corner to an old unmaintained barbed wire fence running east and south from the
fence corner, approx. 90% down on the ground is S86W (true bearing) 143' distant. The fence line
passes 10' south of the corner monument. From the fence corner, the fence runs straight to the
Quarter corner E12 and its direction closely approximates the Section line E13 to E12, produced
northerly.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(E11) Found 1.5" O.D. iron pipe.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
11" Y.Birch S48E 7.8' old blazes (1976 NBT)
7" Sugar N22W 14.8' do do
12" Sugar S08W 15.5' mrkd "S32 NBT"
6" Sugar N74W 18.3' "S29 NBT"
Set cedar post adjacent. Bearings are magnetic.

(3) Set 1"IDx32" I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
The mon. leans a little west. Top-center of the
cap marks the corner position. Set measuring nail
with MDNR tag in the side of:
4" Sugar N38E 18.45' mrkd "1/16S BT"
4" Sugar S70E 9.6' do
10" Sugar S20W 18.9' do
10" twin Sugar N70W 1.1' do
Cedar post adjacent. Bearings magnetic.
