

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

On a Michigan Highway drawing, dated 1948, for US-45, there is shown a 1" Iron Pin a distance of 1738.63 feet from the centerline of the highway along a gravel Township road. I did not find the iron pin but found the fence post to the North which was used for one of the ties. The fence continues to the North. I accepted the corner location because of the evidence found and its consistency with the original G.L.O. notes. I monumented the corner as described in "C' below.
