I, Joseph C. Domitrovich, in a field survey on June 6, 19 97 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1845 - William A. Burt, D.S., set Ironwood post.
24" Cedar S 35° W 8 links
24" Hemlock N 47° E 24 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found a fence intersection at the corner position. Fences run to the North and West. I found the scattered remains of a large Cedar stump at GLO bearing and distance from the fence intersection.

I accepted the fence intersection as the corner position. It works reasonably well with stream crossing to South and with corners North and West. Corner falls 12' West of centerline of an old railroad grade.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" x 48" iron pin with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T.51N, R.40W; S. 8, S. 9, S. 16, S. 17; P.S. 37273.
