Domitrovich, in a field survey on December 4, 1996 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1845 - William A. Burt ran West corrected.

At 39.70 chains, 1/4 Corner fell in River. At 48.53 chains, he crossed River and set post.
16" Cedar, S 30° E 12 links

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories.
I re-established the corner position by single proportionate measurement.
Corner falls 11 feet South of blazed line to West.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" x 48" rebar with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: M.C.; S.1, S. 12; T51N, R. 40W; 1996;
P.S. 37273; COUNTY REMONUMENTATION. Corner falls 26' +/- South and 100' +/- West of West bank of Ontonagon River.
