

5. Private Claims

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. The course of the Ontonagon River has changed dramatically since 1845. The river no longer runs between the Meander Corner and the Section corner as called for in the original field notes. It now runs East of the Section corner. I re-established a position for the meander corner by single proportionate measuremnt between the Section corner and % corner. (SEE BACK FOR SKETCH)
