I, Earl W. Applekamp, in a field survey on May 22, 1998, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Austin Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor, August 29, 1845. Set wood post.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence remains. In the mid 1940's Copper Range Cruisers marked the corner and subsequently it was tied to the Copper Range coordinate system. In early 1960's the area was stripped for borrow to construct a tailings dam. This altered the land greatly. I relocated the corners using the coordinates on record for the corner. This position fell in a large pond of water. I accepted the position and set two witness corners. The position of the corner is in conformance with the original field note calls. The corner is located at N34936.50 & E37033.35 Copper Range Coordinate System.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Because the corner position falls in a pond, I set two witness corners on the Section Line West of the true corner. These monuments are 2 1/2" x 30" split base aluminum pipe, with a 3" stamped cap, the first witness monument is stamped, County Remonumentation, T51N R41W, W.M., S31, S32, N89°-25'-47"E, 673.43', 1998, P.S. 17610. The second Witness Monument has the same stamping, except distance is 829.46'.
