

SECTION

1, Joseph C. Domitrovich, in a field survey on March 31, 1998, do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1/2 Corner Common to Sections 1 and 12, T51N, R41W

1846- S.W. Higgins set a post:

1932- Milton R. Eva RLS # 1767 for Supervisor's Plat of Government Lot 1, Section 1, T51N, R41W, set a permanent metal monument S87°26'W 2734.6' from the Southeast Corner of Section 1, (an angle left of 87° 26' off of the township line)

1962- Michigan State Highway Dept. (M.S.H.D.) Highway Construction plans for M-64 show the corner as a ¾" iron

pipe and show 4 witnesses:

16" W.Birch N25°W 13.86'

8" Maple

N55°E 12.12'

8" W.Birch

S55°E 11.40

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of original comer or accessories. Distances along this Section line are considerably longer than called for by the original Government Surveyor, and he seems to have missed a substantial stream only 220'+/- to the east (Halfway Creek). I believe this is the result of either gross error or fraudulent work by the original Government Surveyor.

I recovered a 3/2" iron pin driven alongside a 3/2" bent iron pipe as called for by M.S.H.D. None of the M.S.H.D. bearing trees remain. It now falls in the lawn area of a house to the west. This comer position works very well with distance and angle left off the township line: (87° 29' 48" meas. 2736.22' meas.) This pipe has long been accepted as the 1/4 corner. Therefore have accepted it.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" x 48" iron pin with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION of Hier
