1 to South. He established 3 new bearing trees.

1983- Robert Mick P.S. 16936, in survey recorded on page 59 of survey records shows corner as common and 3 bearing trees matching Lindgren's bearings and distances. He did not indicate what the corner was.

1990- Dennis Destramp P.S. 18983 re-witnessed corner.

1995- Earl Applekamp P.S. 17610 re-established closing corner to the east.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found a 3/4" pipe and a 1/2" iron driven into a 1" pipe. Found one remaining Lindgren bearing tree which matched his bearing and distance to pipe. Found 3 Destramp bearing trees (one was the same as Lindgren's) facing the found pipe. Also found Earl Applekamp closing corner in centerline of Cherry Lane 32.96' to east. Also found Applekamp witness monument 32.80' east of closing corner.

The found pipe works very well with corners to the north. Accepted position of pipe as the Standard Section Corner and replaced with a county monument.

Research on file with County Remonumentation representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner: Corner is an aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter stamped aluminum cap and falls 33' west of centerline Cherry Lane Witnesses:
