

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applies in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- D-7 1/4 Corner comm. to sec.'s 17 & 20, T36N,R2E

Found 1/2"x24" CIR #15410, per L.C.R.C, L.311, p.125, 6" below grade in E-W 2-track and N-S 2-track 12' West. Accepted found 1/2" x 24" CIR as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Replaced found CIR with a standard DNR monument, placed monument 1' below grade. Found no other evidence to dispute location for corner.

E-7 Sec. Corner comm. to sec.'s 16,17,20,21, T36N,R2E

Found Presque Isle Co. monument, a stamped 3" dia. brass cap on a concrete monument 2" below grade in intersection of trail roads N-S & E-W. Found 22-24" Yellow Pine stump that fits bearing and distance to GLO. Accepted found Presque Isle Co. monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Found no other evidence to dispute the location for the corner.
