O'Brien, in a field survey on 11/22, 19 99 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Sept. 7, 1845 J. Burt, DS set qr. sec. post Cedar 8 S35° 4 Do 16 N67°W 12

Aug. 28, 1906 Eugene H. Ford, County Surveyor notes "original corner witness still plain. Cedar 12 in N36°E 4 l." in Liber 1 Record of Surveys page 52.

Jan. 8, 1952 Carl Christensen, County Surveyor recovered Cedar 8" N35°E 4 links and set 4' length of 2" iron pipe filled with concrete, brass cap on top stamped to identify w/C.C. initials.

1977 Thomas P. O'Brien, PS found pipe w/cap recorded in Liber 1, page 163 of surveys.

1978 Douglas Hooth, RLS found 2" pipe w/brass cap in Liber 1, page 189 of corner records.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

Nov. 22, 1999 Thomas P. O'Brien, PS found 2" pipe w/brass cap stamped to identify and C.C. initials. Added witnesses.
