Szyszkośki</u>, in a field survey on <u>£8 Ray 25, 1993</u>, 19 do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in times 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law: established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(EB) Quarter common to Sections 20-21. Original corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Guy H. Carleton, 1850. Original

BTs: Sugar 10 \$400 15 links, Ironwood 8 N72E 41 links. Found no subsequent record.

(E9) Section corner common to Sections 20-21-28-29. Corner previously recorded by David B. Babbitt RLS, in 1983 as follows: '1' pipe with plastic R.L.S. cap buried at intersection of roads North and East. New bearings: Tag in 18" H. maple S70W 51.9', tag in 10" M. Birch S29W 43.85', tag in power pole S3tE 33.2'.

(10-Sec. 17) South 1/16 corner between sections 18/17. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(EB) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no evidence of prior monumentation and no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner. Reestablished the corner by single proportionate measurement to the original record between monumented section corners 2641.58° north and south. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" cast aluminum MONR tablet, appropriately stamped.

(E9) Found and accepted Babbitt's 1" capped pipe, buried beneath the ground surface in good condition. All 1983 witnesses are still in place and at record bearing and distance from the monument with the exception of the 18° H. Haple, which has been cut. Marked additional mitnesses as shown below.

(10-Sec. 17) Found no evidence of prior monumentation or evidence of use at corner location. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between monumented 1/4 corner 1321.48' north and monumented section corner 1321.48' south. At the position for the corner, placed a 1"x32" iron pipe capped with a 4" cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped.
