DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO NOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

Corner located in 1963 by W. J. Wallace and A. O. Enger. Pipe in place, set by unknown surveyor about 25 years ago, and witnessed as follows: White Spruce 12 N74W 21 links and White Spruce 12 SédE 51 links. The latter has a single large face at base of tree which is scribed, from top to bottom, "BT, 1/4, 31". The former appears to have been similarly marked, but blase is covered with overgrowth.

There is a rotted hemlock stump, identifiable by bark, bearing N3CW 10 links from the pipe, presumably an original BT as given in original field notes. Distances north and south to stream crossings are in good agreement with position of the pipe, although the stream bed has shifted somewhat since the original survey was made.
